Participation fee	CHF 20 per participant The Coaches are exempt from the participation fee for competitions. The basic course pass is no longer required for the fee exemption. All accompanying persons who do not meet the definition of coach are «Other Persons» and pay the full participation fee. The amount must be paid in cash on site. Eligibility	Participation is open to all people with intellectual disabilities. Further information can be found here . Special Olympics Switzerland requires that the participating athletes are physically fit and, if necessary, that all medical clarifications (e.g. atlanto-axial instability test for people with trisomy 21) and measures have been taken so that they can practise their sport without injury.
